## Lemoore Recreation Men's Rules

- 1. 10 players on the field.
- 2. Schedule determines home team. Home team will be on the 3<sup>rd</sup> base side.
- 3. Five minute forfeit rule.
- 4. Line ups need to be turned into the scorekeeper 10 minutes before game time.
- 5. No more than 12 can bat. The rest must be substituted in.
- 6. Batter will begin with 1-1 Count and NONE to waste (batter is out on a fouled third strike).
- 7. NO SENIOR BATS! (If a batted ball caused injury to a pitcher, bat will be confiscated for testing.)
- 8. ONLY rostered players allowed in the dugout and on the field of play.
- 9. Unlimited courtesy runners. If the courtesy runner is still on base when it is their turn to bat, they are out. No rabbit!
- 10. No new inning starts after 50 minutes.
- 11. Run rule: 10 runs after five.
- 12. No lead offs. The base runner can leave on pitchers release.
- 13. Pitching will be six to twelve foot arc. (judgment call by the umpire)
- 14. No warm-ups after game starts.
- 15. Home run limit: One homerun per inning. After that, it is an out.
- 16. NO PROTESTS. UMPIRES DECISION IS FINAL!
- 17. NO ALCOHOL IN OR AROUND THE DUGOUTS, OR THE PUBLIC PARK!
- 18. NO SMOKING ON THE FIELD OF PLAY OR IN THE DUGOUTS!
- 19. All team rosters must be signed by each player and properly submitted to the Lemoore Parks & Recreation Office or scorekeeper before the first game of the season. Any player that is on the roster, but has NOT signed it is still eligible to play once the roster is signed.
- 20. Additional players can be added to the roster any time before the 2<sup>nd</sup> game or the season. New players must sign roster and release from liability from at the Parks and Recreation Department or score keeper/attendant.
- 21. Any player found to be intoxicated will be asked to leave the premises and the team will forfeit the game. The intoxicated player will be out of the league for the remainder of the season.
- 22. Lemoore Parks & Recreation has a Zero-Tolerance Policy for physical or verbal abuse to a player, a spectator, the umpire or staff member while on the field play and/or on the premises of Kings Lions Complex. If an offensive player walks onto the playing field they will be asked to leave only once. If they do not return to the dugout, the game will be forfeited. Two forfeits during a season because of altercations will be dismissal of the ENITRE team from the league with no refunds.
